

## Disclosure of salaries in excess of £100,000 - 2024-25

### Introduction

As set out in the Academy Trust Handbook, the Trust is required to disclose annual salaries in excess of £100,000, in £10k bandings, for the previous year ended 31 August on an annual basis.

# **Publication of Pay**

2.29: The trust must publish on its website in a separate readily accessible form the number of employees whose benefits exceeded £100k, in £10k bandings, for the previous year ended 31 August. Benefits for this purpose include salary, employers' pension contributions, other taxable benefits and termination payments.

The Academy Trust has not entered into an off-payroll arrangement with someone who is not an employee.
